This Risk Assessment covers the hazards associated with erecting, using and dismantling Boyatt Wood Parish Council Event Gazebo

Councillors and staff are responsible for their own wellbeing, and expected to wear appropriate clothing, for the weather conditions. If you suffer from any medical condition or allergises, carry your own medication. Activities that do not follow these guidelines are carried out at your own risk.

When the Gazebo is used at Festivals/Events it is expected that the area will be left clean and tidy, and all rubbish is disposed of responsibly.
