<b>Date and amount received</b>

<b>How did you use the funds</b>
<p>We replaced a broken and dilapidated wooden bench on the river footpath at Ham Farm. The original bench was installed in 2012 as part of the Itchen Heritage Project and has fallen apart. It has been repaired in the past by residents, but it was in a poor state of repair and a danger to anyone that used it. We replaced the bench with a bespoke rustic solid oak 3-seater bench and installed it using local volunteers.</p>
<b>Benefit to Organisation</b>
<p>It fulfils our charities objects to restore and enhance the Itchen Navigation for the benefit of the environment, wildlife and the public.</p>
<b>Benefit to Community</b>
<p>All the Boyatt Wood residents that use the popular river walk will benefit from the repairs and enhancements we will do to the river including replacing this bench. The current bench is unsafe, and the new bench will be safe and provide a resting spot for the less abled.</p>
